

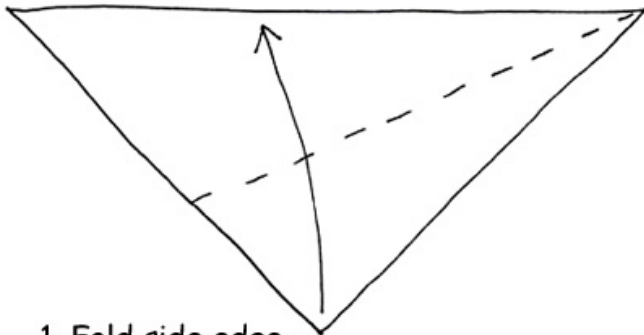
FLAT STEM/LEAF - for use with Flat Tulip

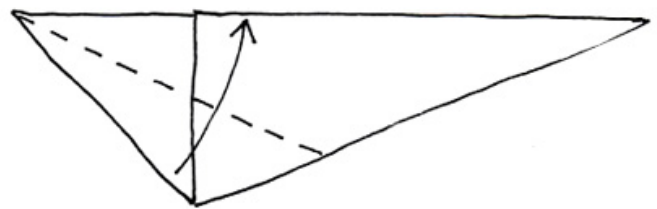
~ Begin with half a square cut on the diagonal ~

Note:

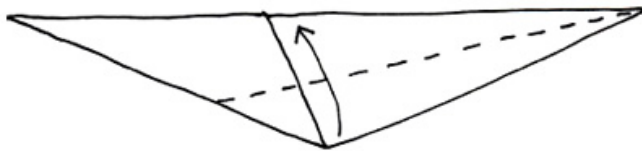
The leaf will show on the left side of the stem when you start folding on the right, as in this diagram. If you want the leaf to point to the right, begin step one by folding the left side first - opposite to the diagram.



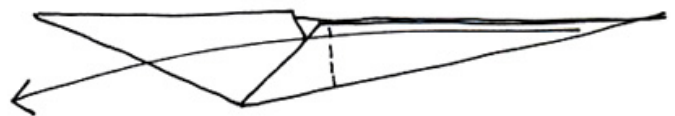
1. Fold side edge up to meet the top edge



2. Now fold up the smaller side up to meet the top edge also



3. Once again, fold the opposite lower side up to meet the top edge



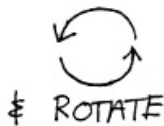
4. Fold the whole piece in half at a slight angle, letting the point land off to the side (as shown in next step)



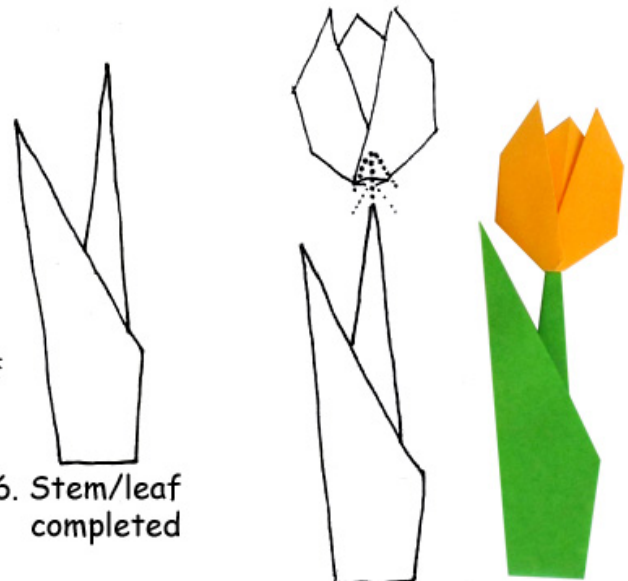
5. Turn model over & rotate so the points are at the top...



TURN OVER



ROTATE



6. Stem/leaf completed

Assembly: Slide top of stem into the small open slit at bottom of tulip
