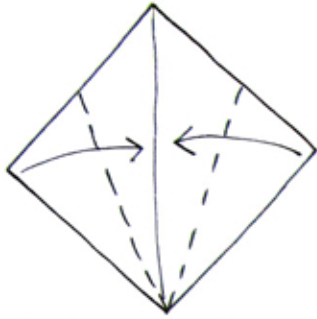


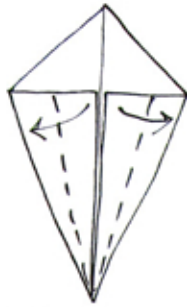
Peacock

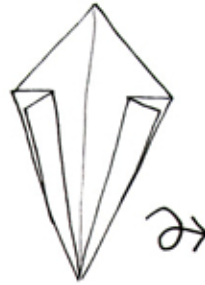
The head & neck will be the color of one side of the paper while the tail will show the opposite side. The side that is showing in step one will become the head and neck; the side that is down will become the tail.



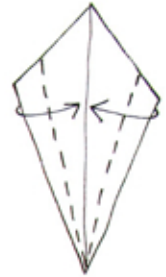
1. Begin with one diagonal pre-creased, then fold 2 sides to this diagonal crease to create a "kite" fold.



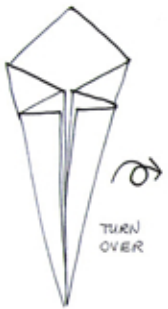
2. Fold inside raw edges out to align with outer edges.



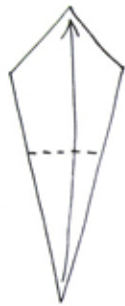
3. Turn model over...



4. Fold edges (all layers) to the center once again.



5. Turn model over...



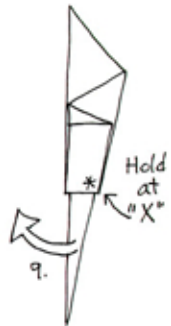
6. Fold in half, bottom to top.



7. Fold top point back down as shown. Note that this fold leaves a space above the bottom edge.



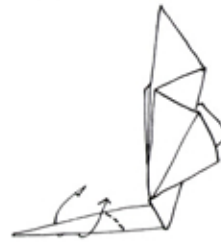
8. Fold model in half, side-to-side.



9. Be sure model is oriented with the folded edge on the left as shown in diagram. With one hand hold at "X"; use other hand to swivel up bottom point. See next step for placement result.



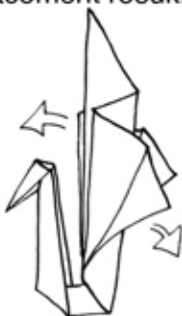
10. Valley-fold single layer at angle shown. Repeat behind.



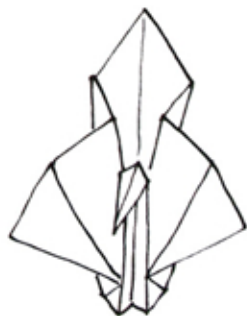
11. Outside reverse-fold to form neck; this is how:
 (a) Fold up to make crease (see angle in next step)
 (b) Crease sharply & unfold
 (c) Refold while opening flap from below and folding up each side again on the new creases...each side of the flap goes to the outside. See next step for result.



12. Follow same outside reverse-fold procedure to form the head: crease sharply, unfold, refold to the outside (see next step to see result).



13. Spread open the tail folds to complete
