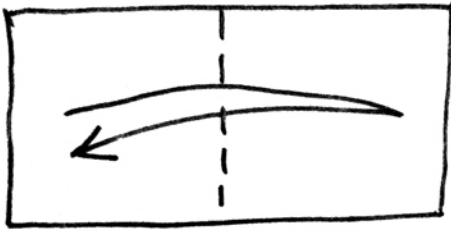


# \$ Shirt

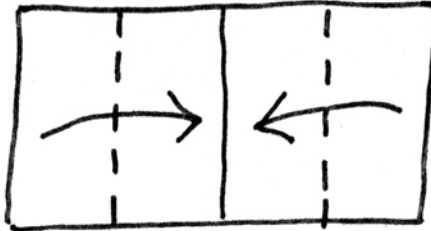

A Money-Fold Shirt; great for a gift or a tip!

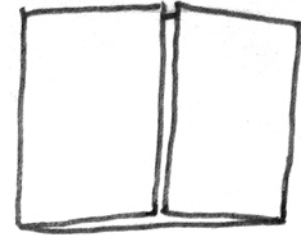


1. With a dollar bill, start with green side down for a green shirt.

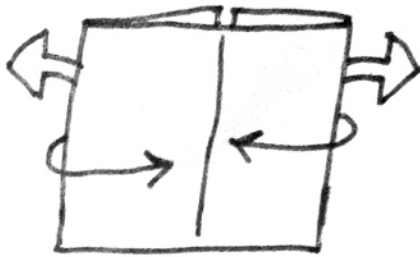
Fold in half side-to-side to find center, crease & unfold



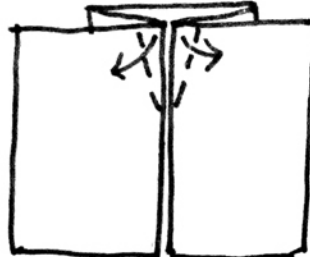
2. Fold sides to center crease



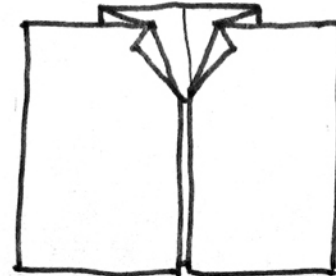
3 Turn model over....



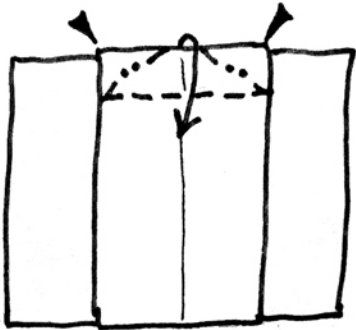
4. While folding sides in to meet at center, allow flaps in back to release & come to front



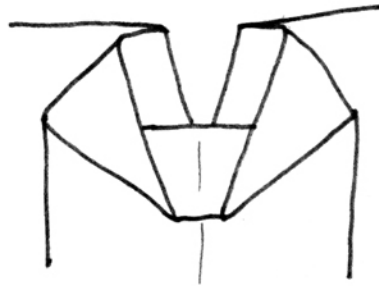
5. Create collar by folding short narrow folds at tops of center sections



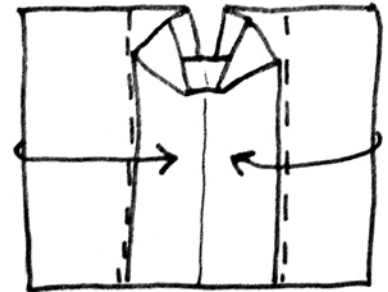
6. Turn model over...



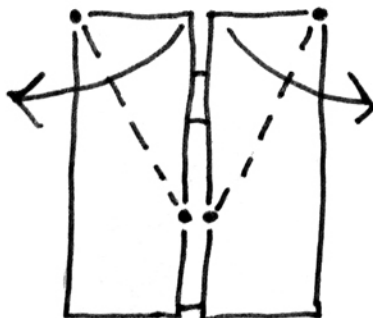
7a. As you fold down a **single** layer at top it will lift top corners of middle section; squash these corners flat at an angle as shown in next step...



7b. ENLARGED VIEW showing results of 7a



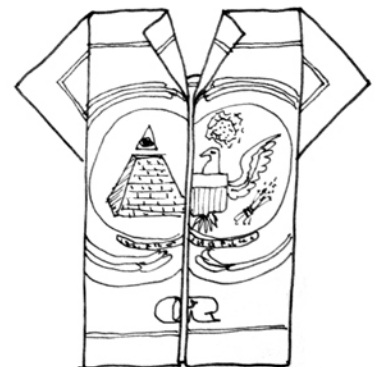
8. Fold each side in towards center, tight against the sides of the mid-section; crease well



9. Create sleeves: Fold out top half of center edges at angle that begins at outer edge & ends about 2/3 down at center edge.



10. Turn model over...



11. Completed model from \$1 bill
